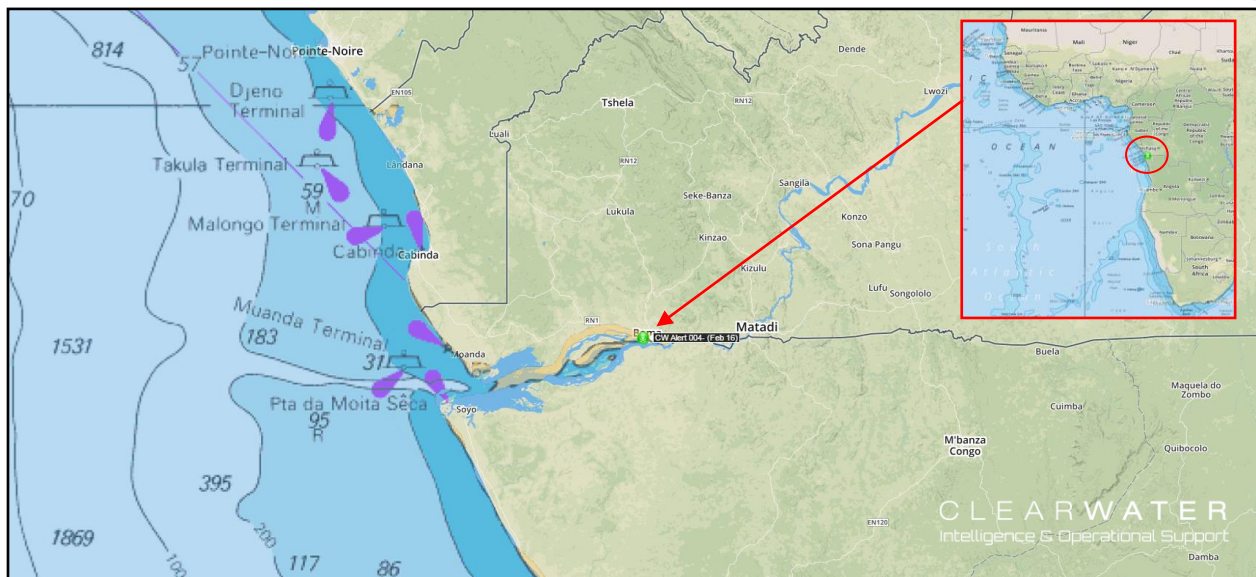
Description of event:

It has been reported that a vessel at anchor was boarded by four robbers armed with knives. As the robbers were spotted the alarm was raised which resulted in the robbers escaping in a small boat with fire hoses and nozzles. No injuries to the crew were reported.
